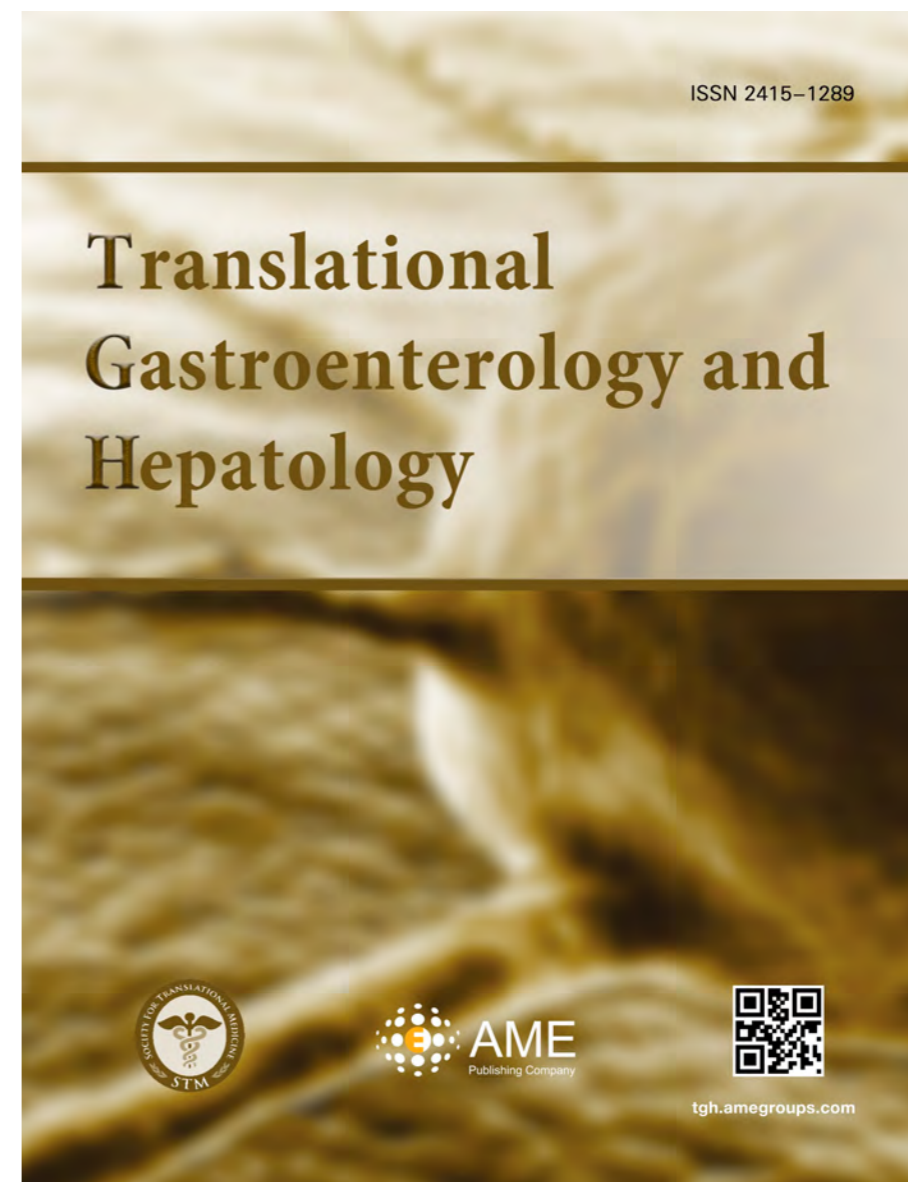

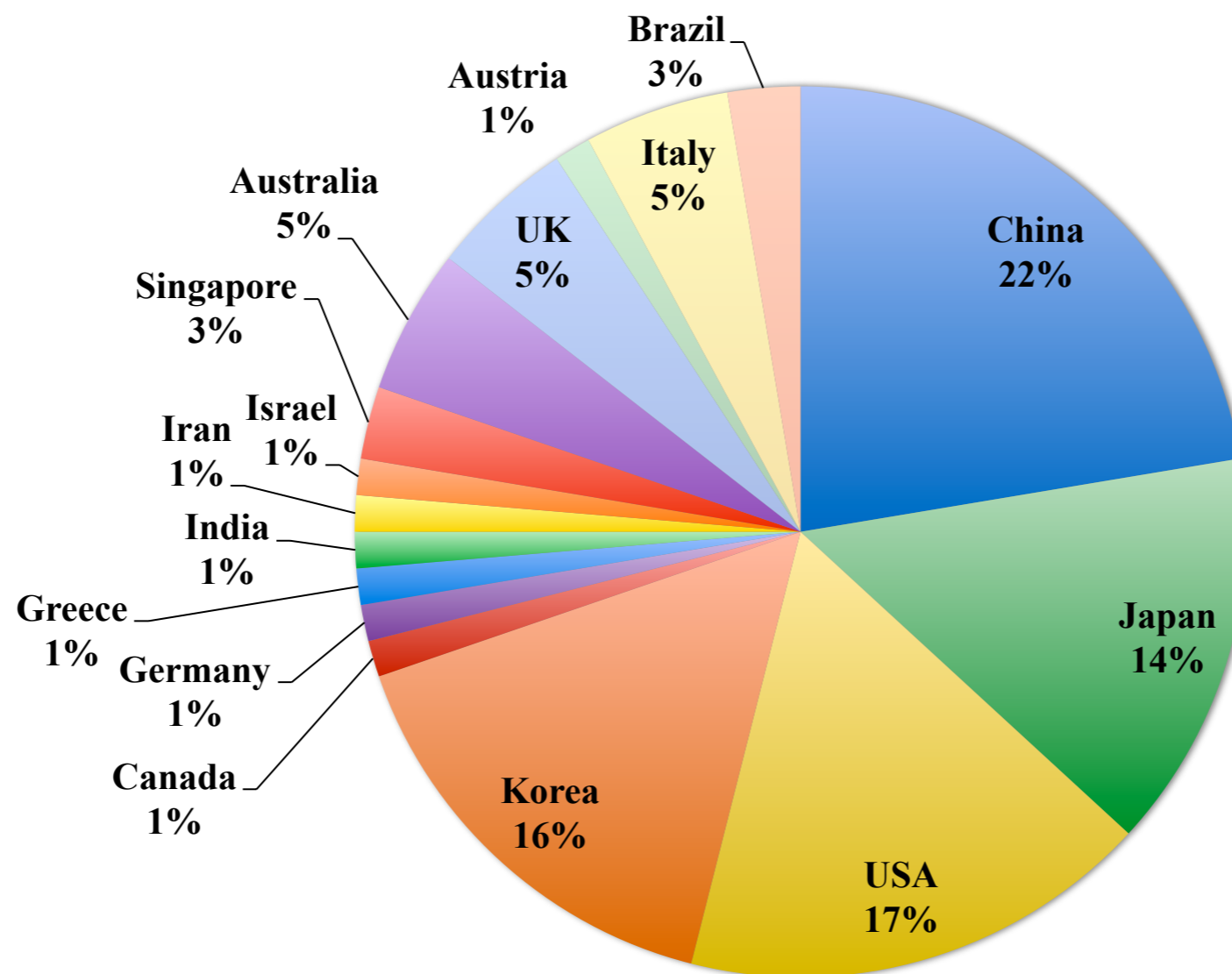

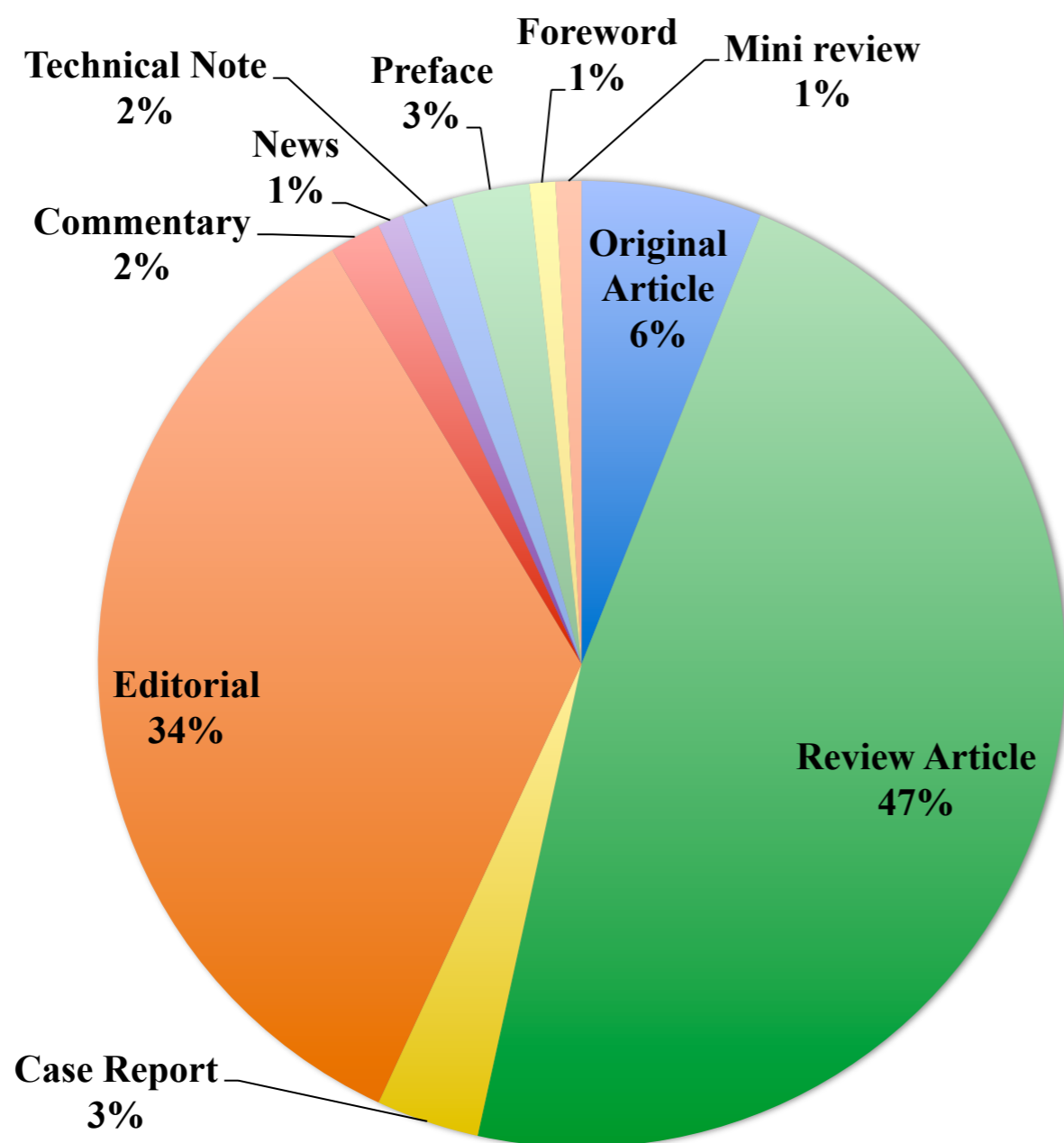

3. Distribution of Editorial Board Members



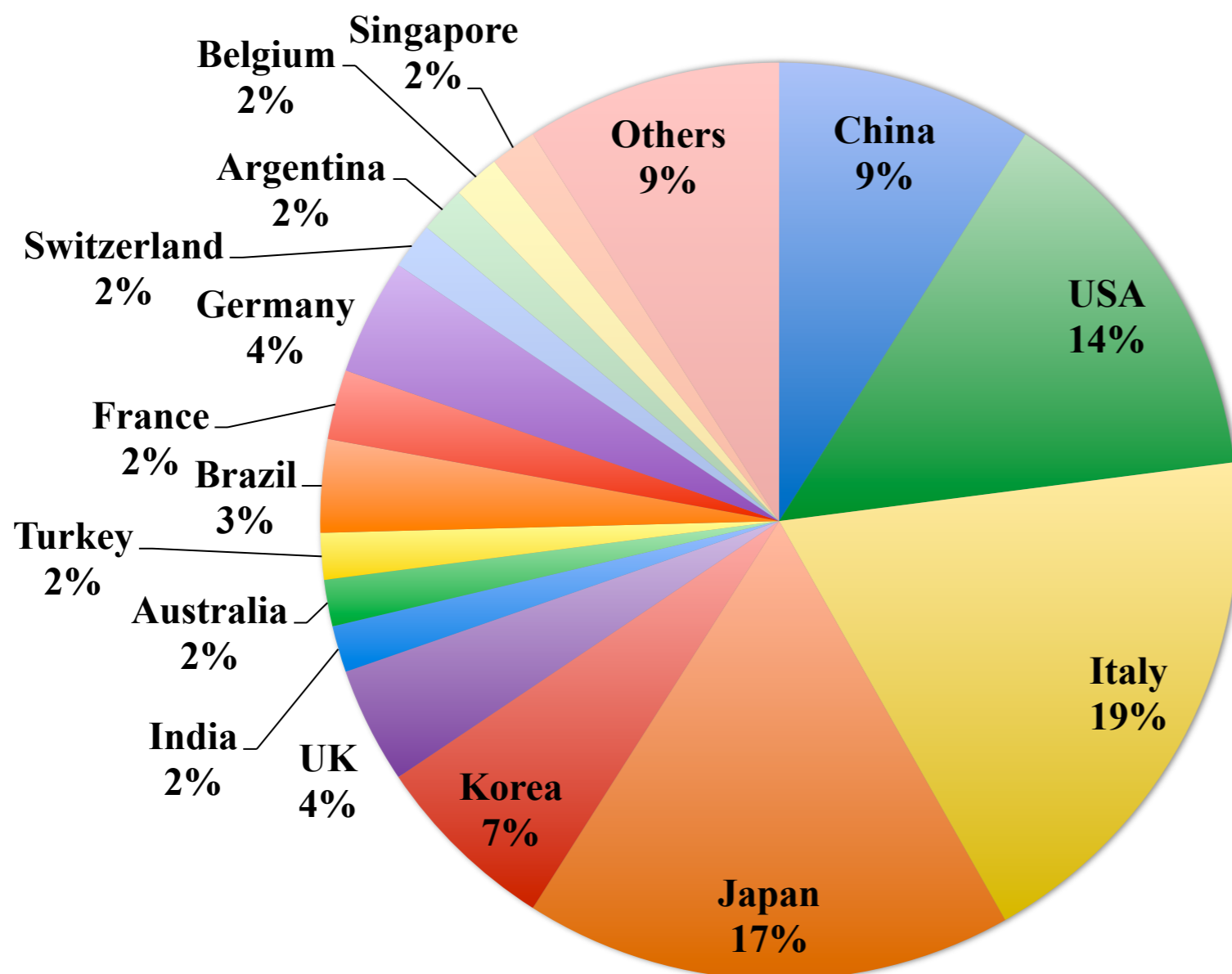

4. Diverse Types of Article Published in 2017



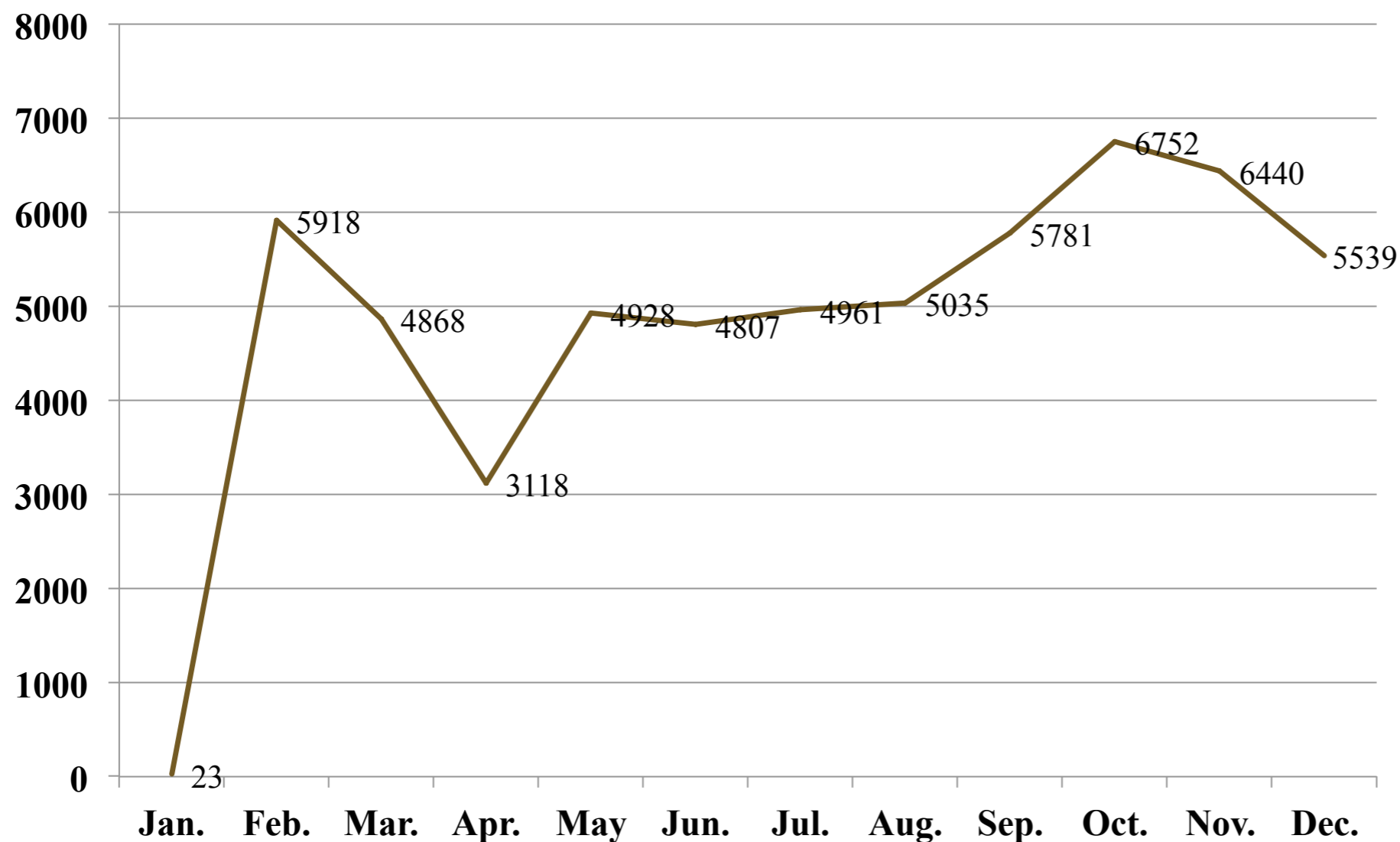
In 2017, TGH has published **116** manuscripts, among which there are **66** review articles, **original** articles and **case** reports. Other article types include technical note, news, preface etc.

Corresponding authors of 116 articles published in 2017 come from **27** countries with 50% of them from Italy, Japan and USA.

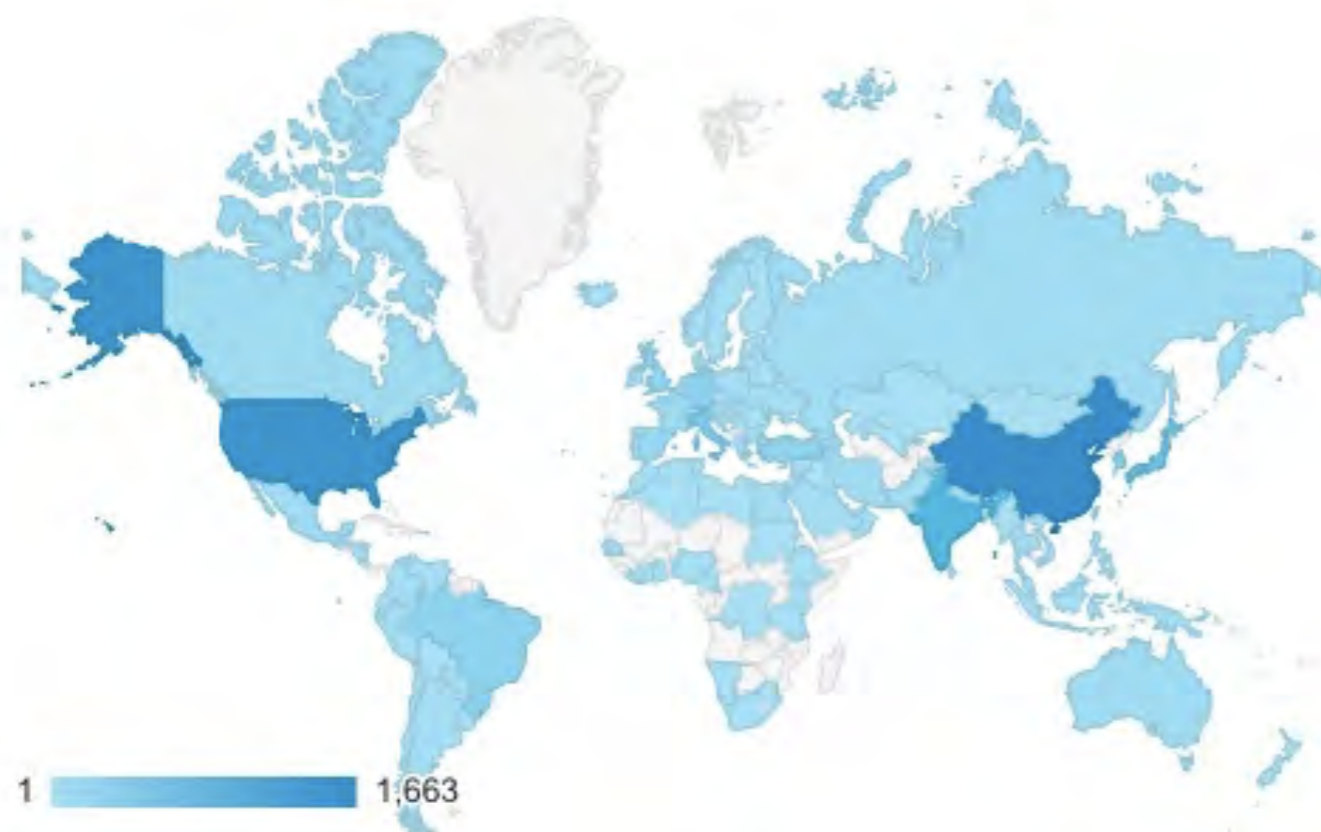
6. Monthly Retrievals in PubMed in 2017
