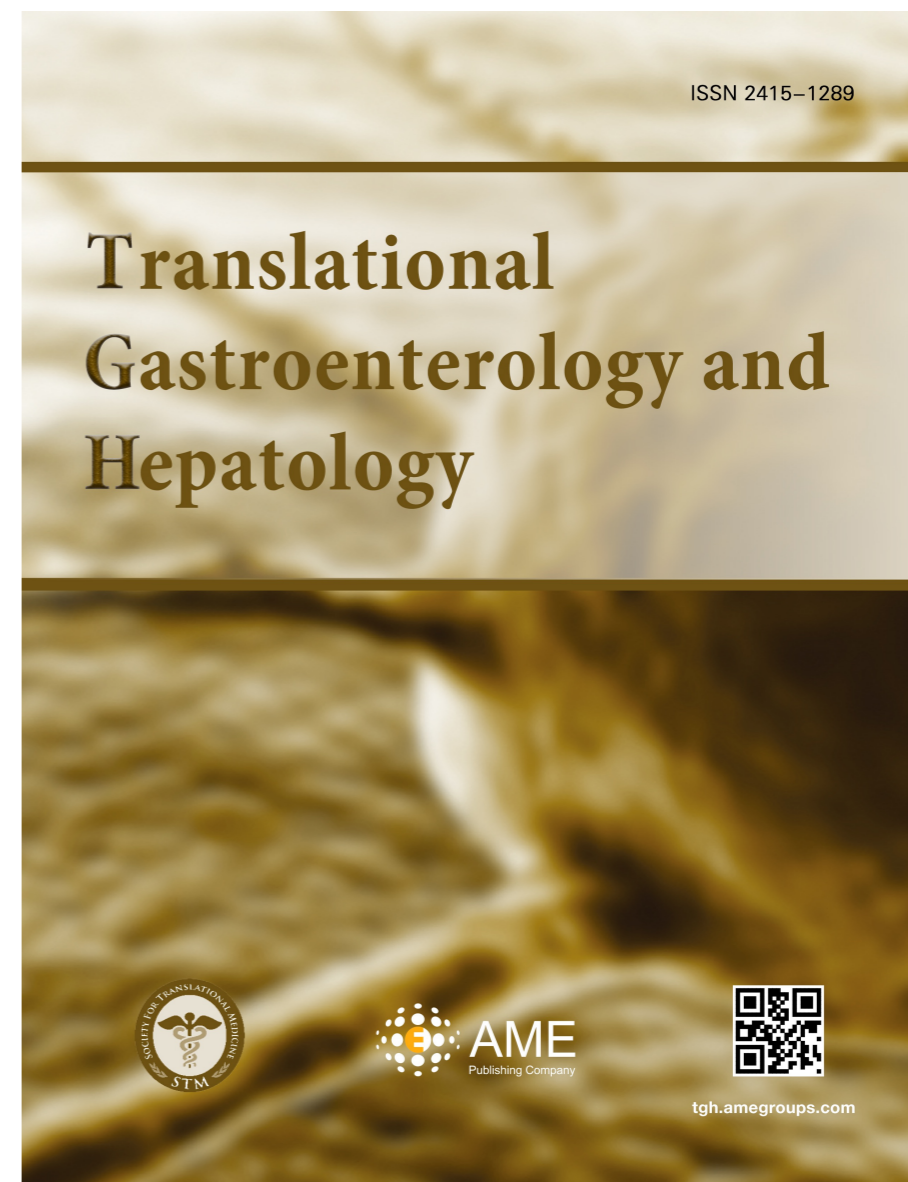

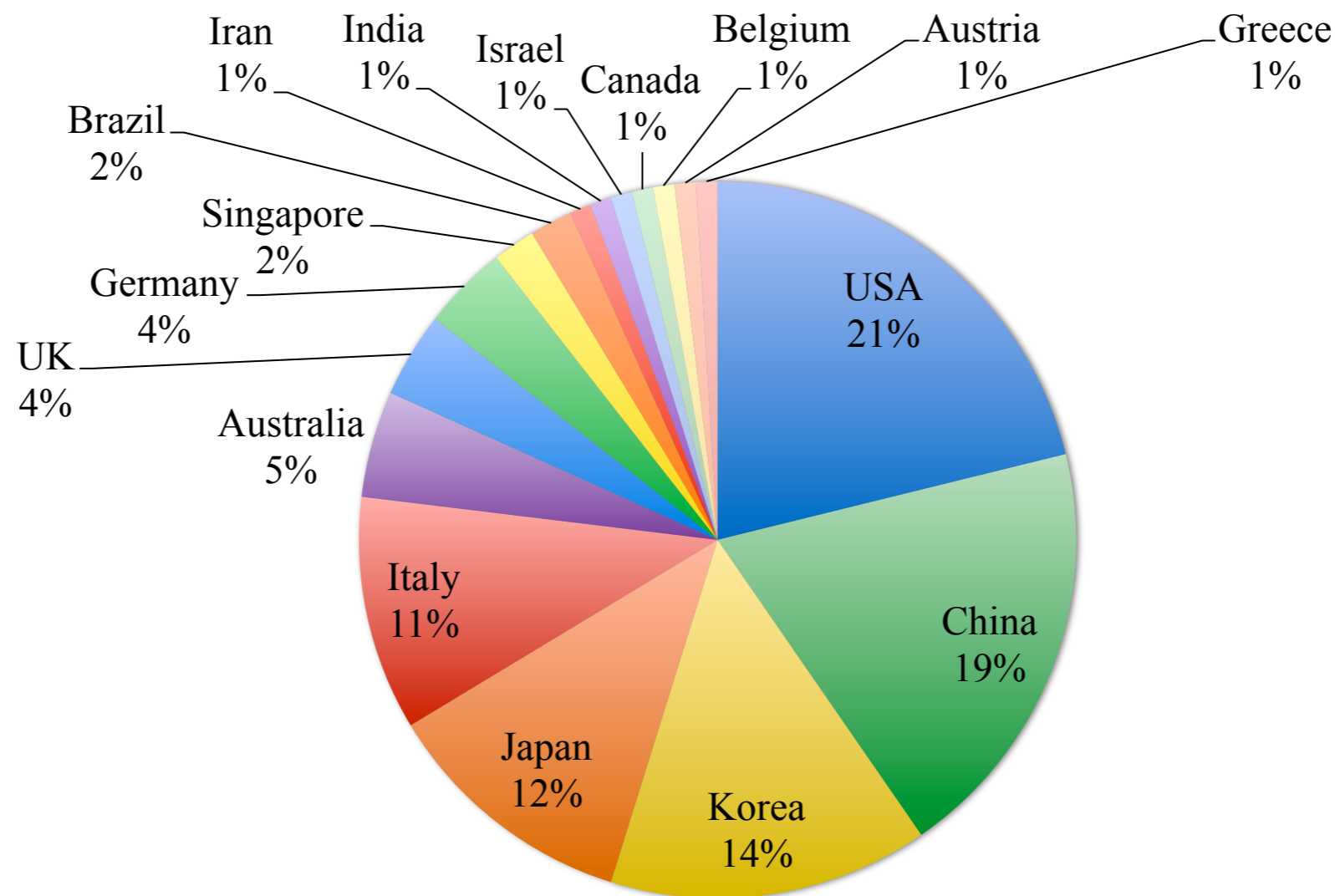

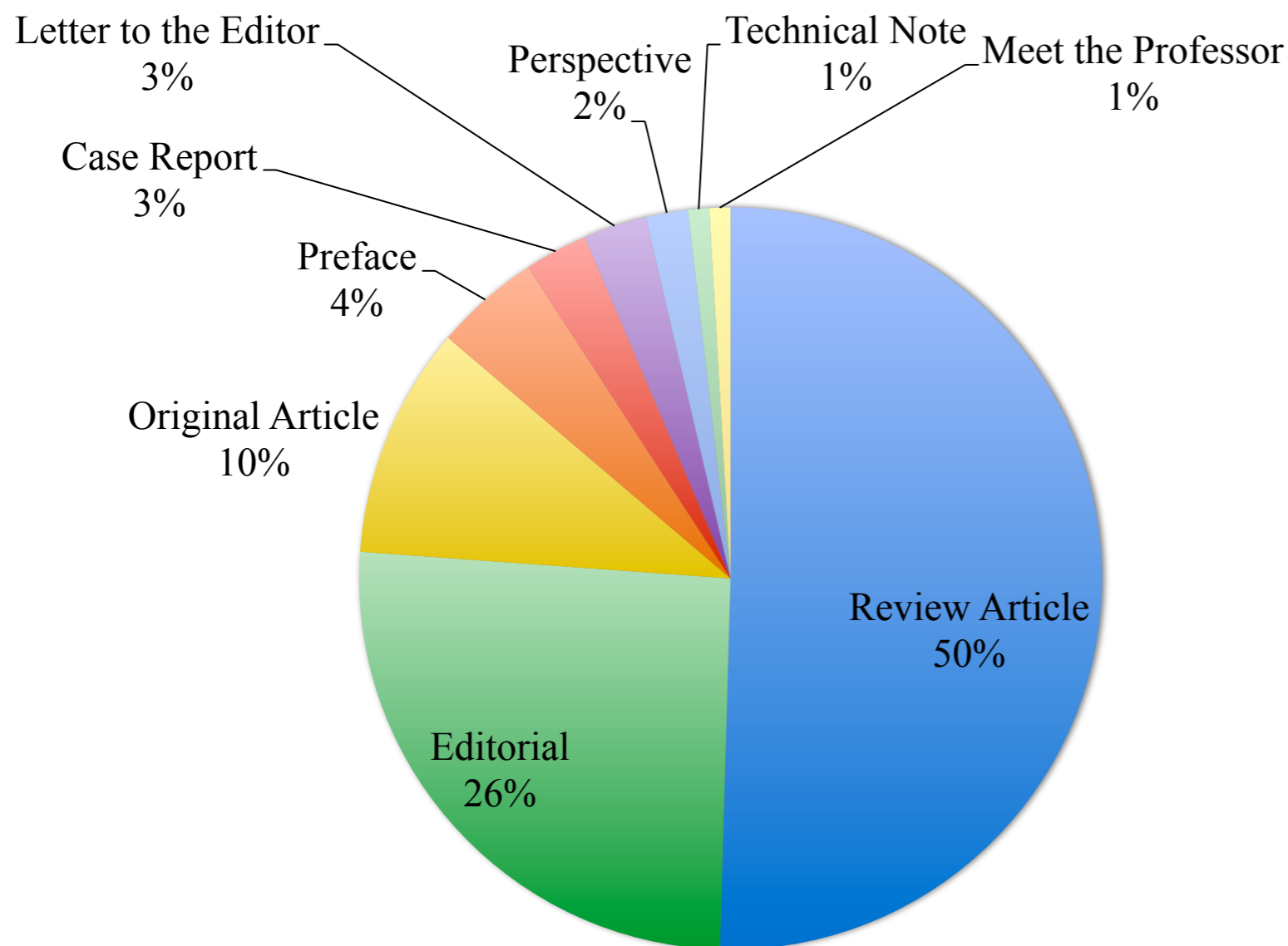

### 3. Distribution of Editorial Board Members



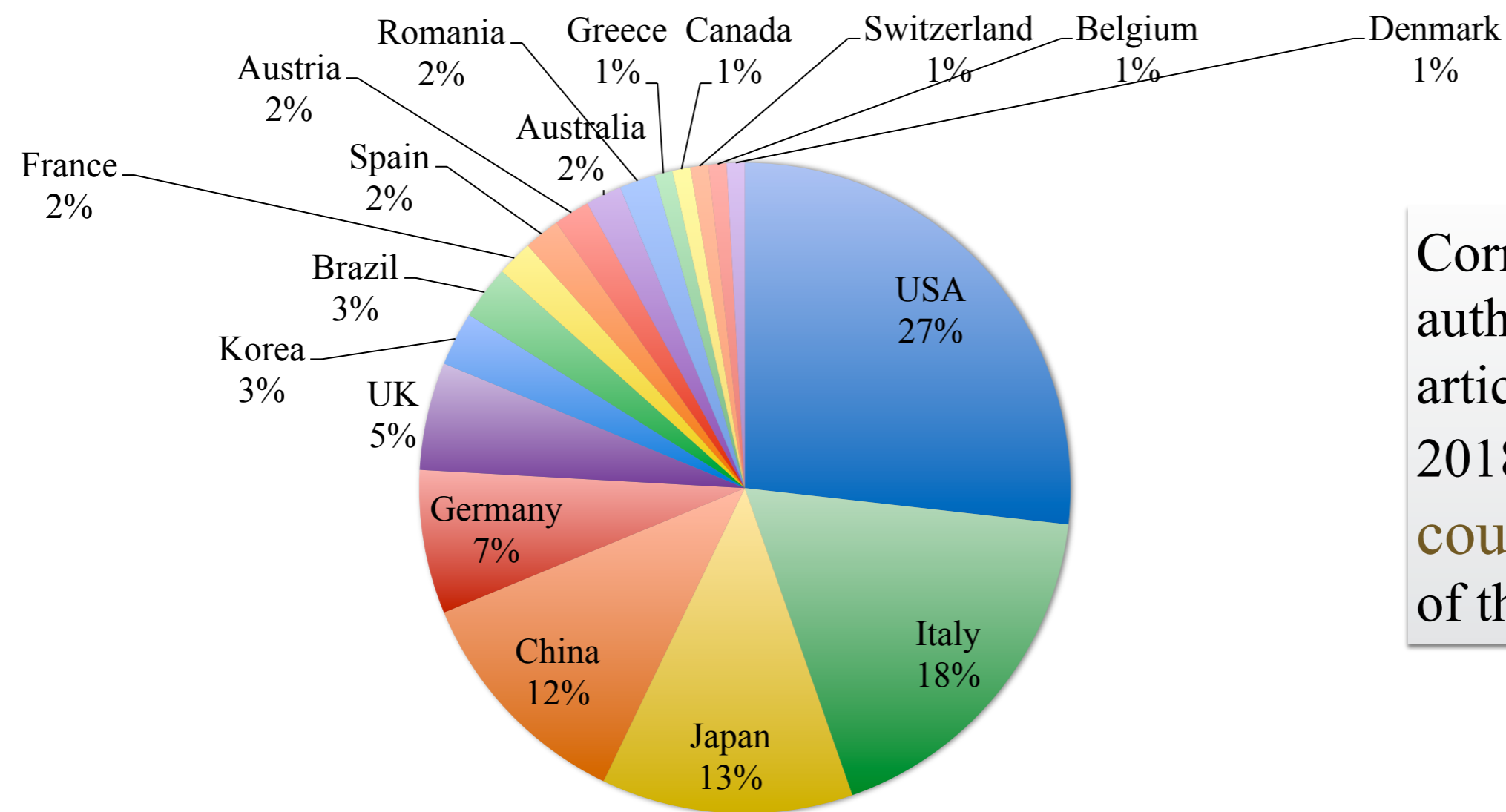

## 4. Diverse Types of Article Published in 2018



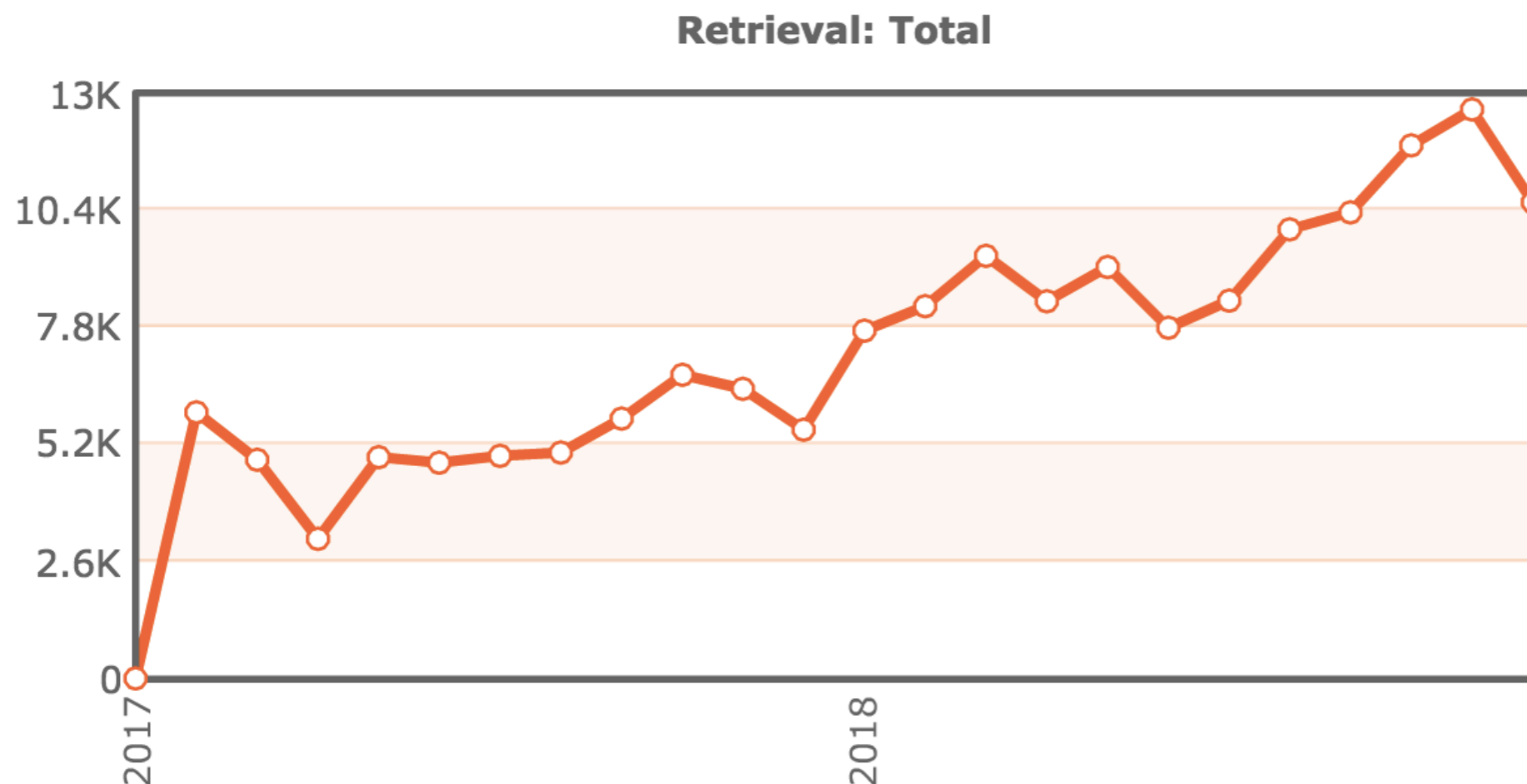
In 2018, TGH has published **109** manuscripts, among which there are **69** review articles, **original** articles and **case** reports.

## 6. Monthly Retrievals in PubMed in 2018

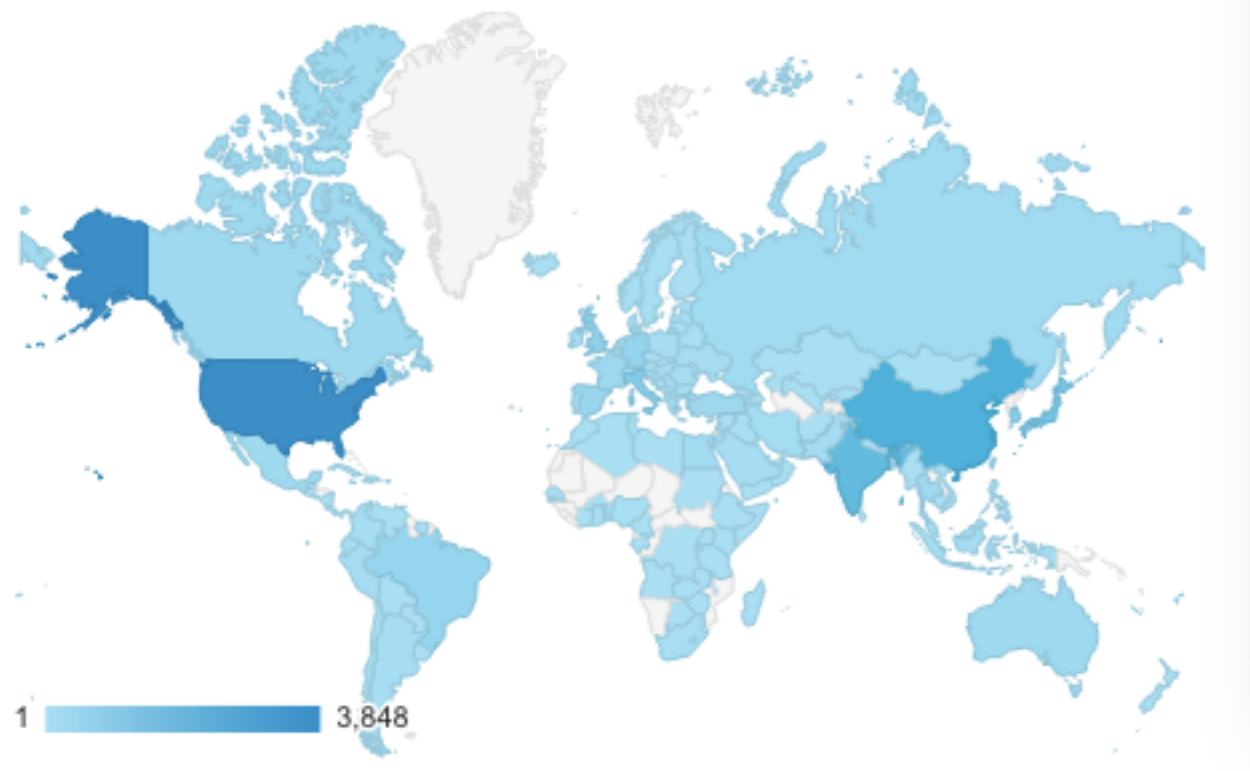


In 2018, the total retrieval of TGH in PubMed is **114,529** times.
